AMTICO STATEMENT OF RECYCLED CONTENT

Amtico uses 100% of our post industrial waste to produce the backing layers of the finished product. Post industrial waste is defined as all excess material derived from the cutting process. The backing layers comprise close to 40% of the weight of the product. Therefore, Amtico flooring averages approximately 40% post industrial waste.

STRATICA STATEMENT OF RECYCLED CONTENT

Stratica uses 100% of our post industrial waste to produce the backing layers of the finished product. Post industrial waste is defined as all excess material derived from the cutting process. The backing layers of Stratica comprise 20% of the weight of the product. Therefore, Stratica flooring averages 20% post industrial waste.
