Steel used in manufacturing of Dunbarton products is from the BOF (Basic Oxygen Furnace) process and contains 23% post-consumer recycled content steel, and 7.3% post-industrial recycled content steel, or 26.65% (post consumer + ½ post-industrial) combined recycled percent. Paints used are a high solids polyester baking enamel with 2.8 VOC and zero Haps.

Dunbarton's Architect Development Department is responsible for identifying and developing architect and building professional speaking opportunities and the development of architectural presentations.

Seminars are given throughout the United States providing building expertise and Lunch & Learn seminars to Architectural firms, AIA and CSI Chapters as well as Building Code officials.
