New concrete should be allowed to cure a minimum of 30 days before applying any finish. Steel trowelled, hard or glassy smooth concrete should be mechanically abraded to obtain proper adhesion. Curing agents or concrete hardeners can prevent adhesion of any coating unless the surface is mechanically abraded. Under normal conditions acid etching is not recommended but new dusty or chalky concrete should have a coat of Stonite Masonry Conditioner applied before AllFlor is used as a finish. AllFlor is self-priming over unfinished wood and does not require a wood	Pastel Medium
